-a hidden gem from the volcanic isle of Ischia.

Da Capo *Barbera D'Asti* 2006 40
-blackberry and violets, rich earthy expansiveness.

Argiano *Super Tuscan* 2005 45
-full bodied Tuscan blend that lingers in the mouth.

Romeo *Luzzano* 2003 60
-hearty and leathery with dark cherry and light oak.

Monte Stefano *Barbaresco* 2001 65
-cherry, truffles, fennel, licorice- let the story of this wine open up before you with each course.

Damilano *Barolo* 2004 65
-the Nebbiolo powerhouse, medium bodied, complex tannins and a symphony of flavors.

Villa Girardi *Amarone della Valpolicella* 2003 80
-dark ruby black color, toffee and baked fruits with a silky velvety finish. Oh, the decadence.
